## **NJ Company's Gadget May Help Law-Enforcement Communication**

December 13, 2005 -- It used to be that when a student at Philadelphia's Drexel University used one of the campus' emergency call boxes, a dispatcher had to figure out which security officer to send.

Now, thanks to a new handheld device, campus security will be alerted whenever the box is used and officers instantly will know which of them is in the best position to respond.

DragonForce can cut response times for emergency responders and give law-enforcement officers in the field the same information available to dispatchers at headquarters.

DragonForce was launched today at Drexel, where it was designed.
